Introduction

Summary

Based on various assessments during this reporting period, the University has:

1. Hired academic advisors for colleges to assist in improving graduation rates.
2. A new faculty workload policy has been developed and implemented to further this mission and vision.
3. Thirty additional classrooms were equipped with appropriate technology as part of Phase II of a three year plan to upgrade all classrooms.
4. Redirection of the ORACLE project has resulted in redefined objectives and implementation of the FRS and HRS systems is on schedule to be up and functional in September 2006.
